

Shroud of Turin Exhibition: St. John The Baptist Church will host The Turin Shroud Exhibition from Monday 26th September-Monday 3rd October 2022. This exhibition will display the story and a replica image of the famous Shroud of Turin. The Shroud is widely believed to be the burial shroud of Jesus after his crucifixion. Pope Benedict called the Shroud "An Icon of Love". The exhibition will be able to be viewed from 1pm-9pm on Monday 26th September. From 27th September to 2nd October 9am-9pm.
