

What is a Mission?

Your Parish is about to experience a **Parish Mission**.

This is a special event and time of Grace in the life of your Parish.

A Mission happens only once every few years. It is a great opportunity to slow down and look at your life. It is also a time to examine your relationship with God and those around you.

A Mission is a reminder of the love God has for each one of us and for our world. It is also an invitation to work more closely with God and your local Parish.

As well as Masses and the Mission Services, there is plenty of opportunity to see one of the Mission Priests for Confession. If it's been a long time since your last confession, then don't worry—they're experienced in helping you come back to the Sacraments.

What is a Mission Service?

The Mission Service each night is not a Mass. It consists of hymns, a main sermon, and a devotional action to make concrete the theme that we're exploring. It lasts one hour.


Why Bother?

Who are We?

He is the Vocations Director for the order, and has just taken on the role of coordinating the Parish Mission work that the Redemptorists undertake.
